



CHERRY SHOT HOLE

The symptoms are brown spots on the leaves that die and drop out leaving multiple holes and the oozing of gum from the bark. Affects trees in the Prunus genus, which includes both ornamental and edible Cherries and Plums.

Some control is achieved by spraying with Murphy traditional copper fungicide, Dithane 945 or Bordeaux mixture during early spring. Assist with the general health of the tree by regular feeding (foliar feeding where possible) and keep an eye on the watering too.
